Summer School Course Options for Incoming Freshmen

World Cultures (2 semesters, 1.0 credit)

Health (1 semester, 0.5 credit)

Communication Arts (1 semester, 0.25 credit, early or late class)

Intro to Computer Science - Online (1 semester, 0.5 credit, 1 day of orientation afternoon of June 4)

Computer Applications - Blended (1 semester, 0.5 credit)

Internship in Teaching the Young Child (by application, 1 semester, 0.5 credit)

AP workshops for World History or Human Geography (Friday, June 15 and Friday, June 22)

Algebra 1 (by recommendation, for students wishing to accelerate)

PreAcademy Mathematics (by recommendation, for students enrolling in Algebra 1)

Dates

Semester 1: June 4 - June 21

Semester 2: June 25 - 28, July 9 - 19 (No classes during the week of July 2nd)

All classes meet Monday - Thursday. No classes on Fridays.

Regular summer school classes

7:45am to 1:00pm

Quarter classes (Communication Arts)

7:45am - 10:15am *Early class*

10:30am - 1:00pm *Late class*
