### Final Exams

Monday, May 13	ALL Seniors are in attendance.
Tuesday, May 14	Senior Final Exams ( <i>refer to section below</i> )
Wednesday, May 15	Senior Final Exams ( <i>refer to section below</i> )
Thursday, May 16	No School for Seniors (Senior Breakfast)
Friday, May 17	No School for Seniors (Senior Prom)
Sunday, May 19	Graduation

Seniors will have the option to take their final exam as scheduled on Tuesday, May 14 and Wednesday, May 15.

- Long term projects, presentations, or other experiences for seniors will need to be wrapped up, graded and entered into Aspen no later than 3:30 p.m., Monday, May 13.
- The student will inform the teacher no later than the end of the scheduled class period on Monday, May 13 whether or not the student will be taking the final exam.

If a <b>senior</b> chooses <b>NOT</b> to take their final exam	If a <b>senior</b> chooses <b>TO TAKE</b> their final exam
<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Student does not need to attend the final exam period.</li><li>2. Since the student informed the teacher that he/she will NOT be taking the final exam, the teacher will NOT take attendance for that student.</li></ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Student must notify teacher in advance.</li><li>2. Student reports to the final exam period.</li><li>3. Since the student informed the teacher he/she will be taking the final exam, the teacher will take attendance.</li></ol>

3. The grade the student has going into that final exam would be the FINAL course grade.

Note:

- All students (freshmen through seniors) who sit for an AP exam still have the option to waive their course final exam in that class (same as the last two years).
- Dual credit courses/PLTW that have a restriction on what must occur for finals are excluded from this change. The teacher will follow the dual credit final requirement.

## Textbook, Calculator & Refund Information
