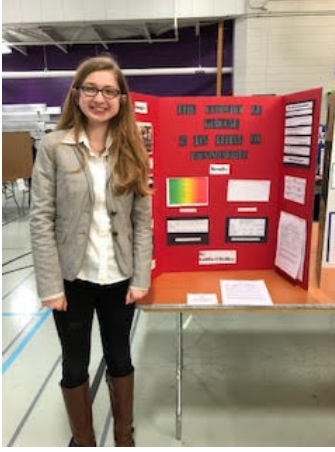
## Color Run
