In the spring of 2018, Maine Township High School District 207 became one of 15 school districts to join the State of Illinois' Competency-Based High School Graduation Requirements Pilot Program. Joining this pilot indicates a major shift in our vision for student learning. In competency-based education, students must demonstrate mastery of important skills and dispositions in order to earn credit, rather than merely receiving credit based upon the time spent in the classroom and grades which are partially determined by non-academic factors. The 2018-2019 school year has been primarily a year of learning for administrators and teachers to begin to fully understand the principles of competency-based education and how we will implement them in District 207 in the years to come.
