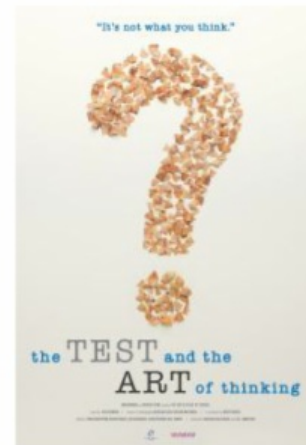

LifeSource, which has its origins in the Chicago area, has been supplying blood to those in need for the past 30 years.

Each pint of blood we collect can help save up to three lives, and will impact the lives of so many more. However, we cannot do this without your help.

We will be signing up students during lunch periods to donate on

Monday, November 12th; Tuesday, November 13th; and Wednesday, November 14th. Any student that is at least sixteen years old is eligible to donate; however, any sixteen or seventeen year old MUST have a [signed permission form](#).

In order to make the signup process easier for students, we ask that the students have the signed (in pen) permission form printed and ready to go for one of the sign up days. PSAT Score Information

PSAT scores are available electronically for individuals to access in December, six to eight weeks after taking the exam. The College Board doesn't have the 2018 PSAT score release date finalized yet, but based on past years, it is expected that the 2018 PSAT scores to be available online around December 10, 2018. **Note schools do not have access to the online scores.** A hard copy of the students score report will be distributed to students in January 2019 after Winter break.

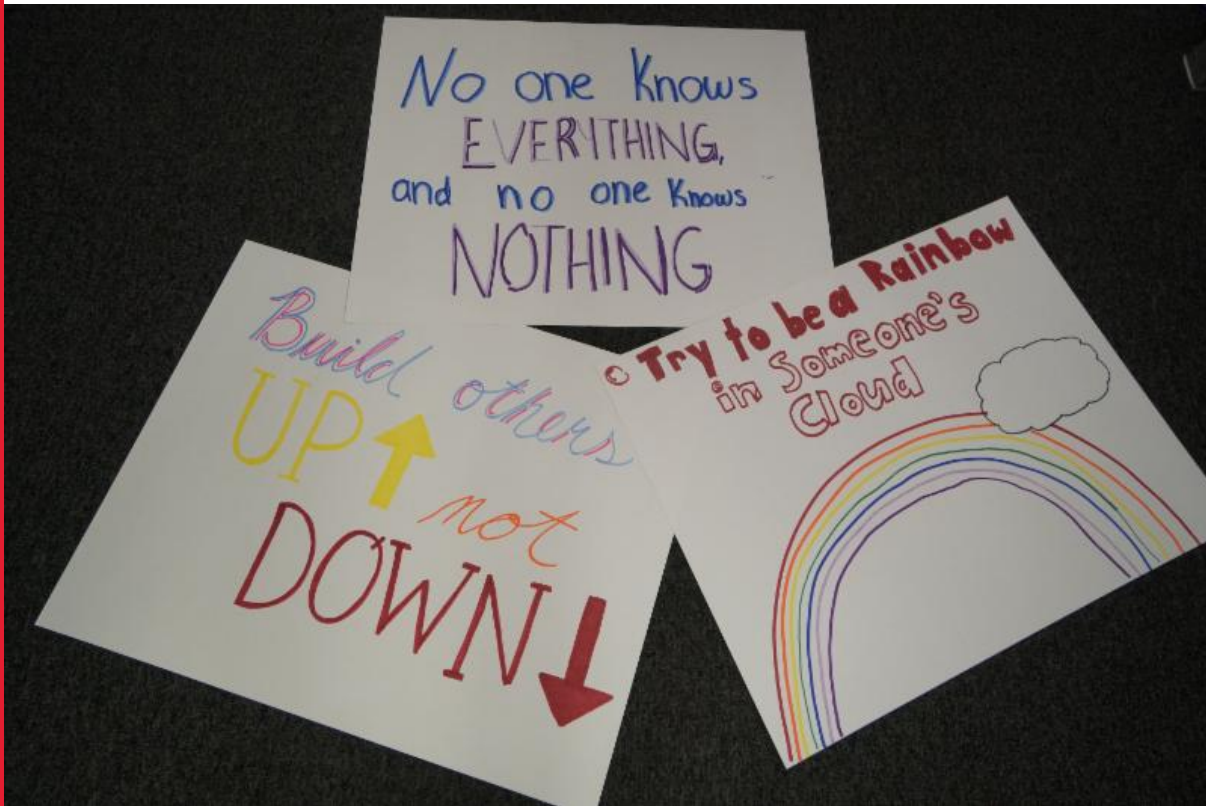

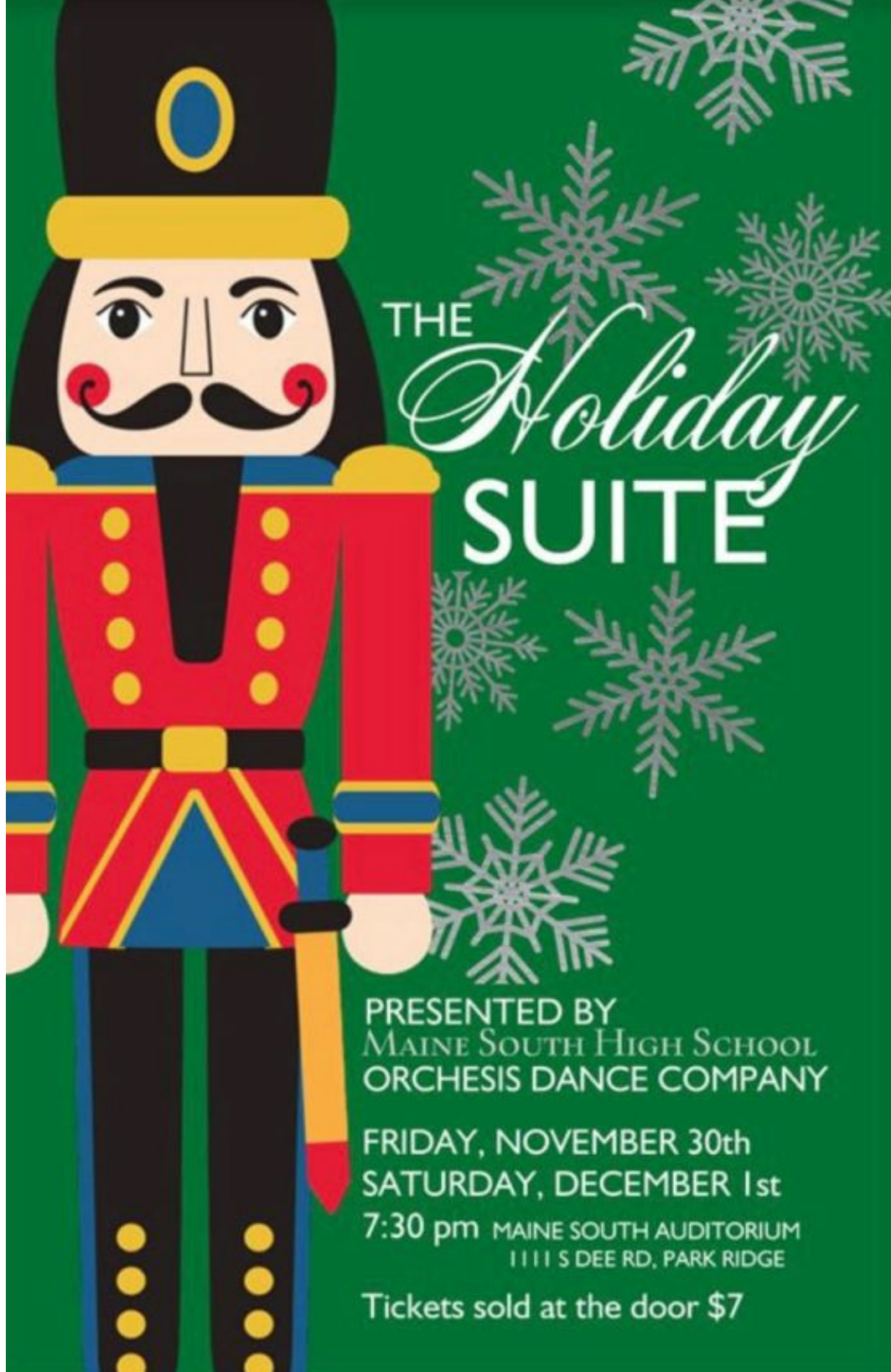

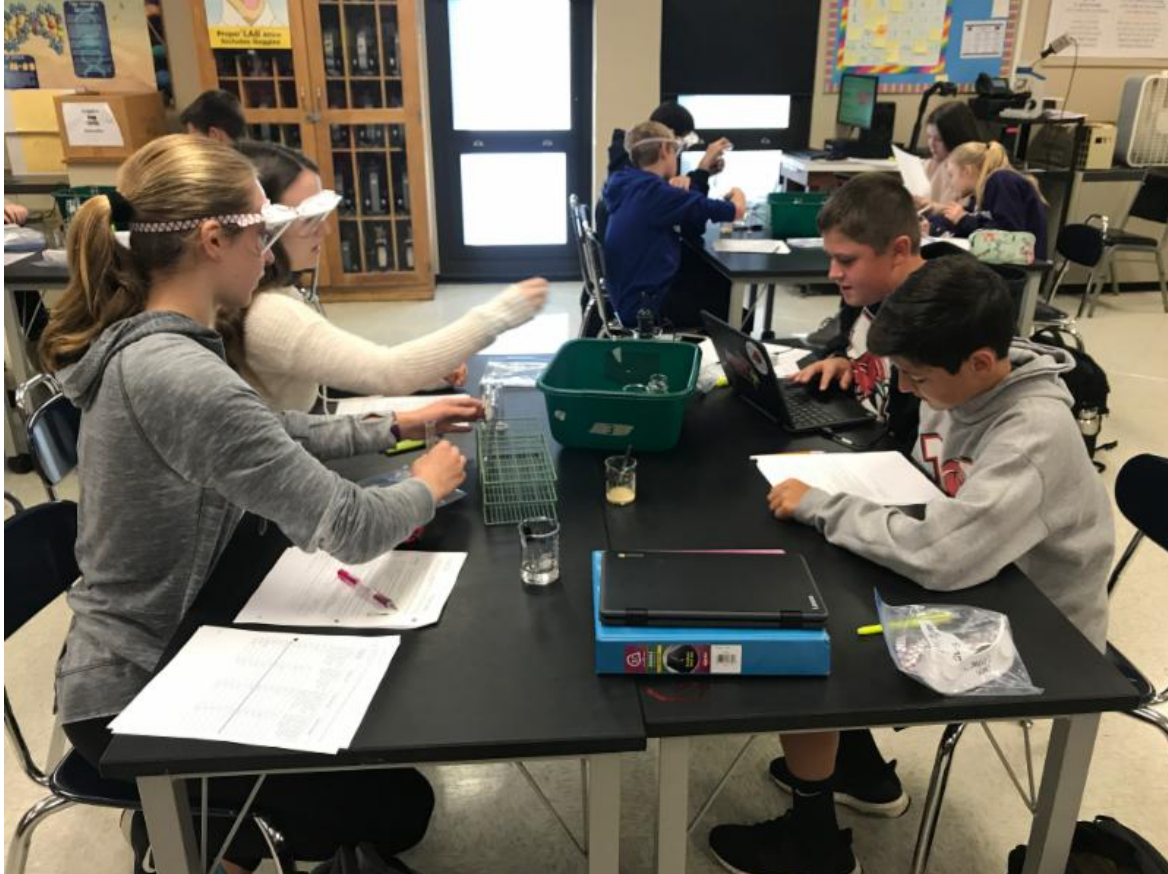
