Meals can be picked up either Tuesday OR Thursday between 2pm-4pm at Door #3 in the Circle Drive.



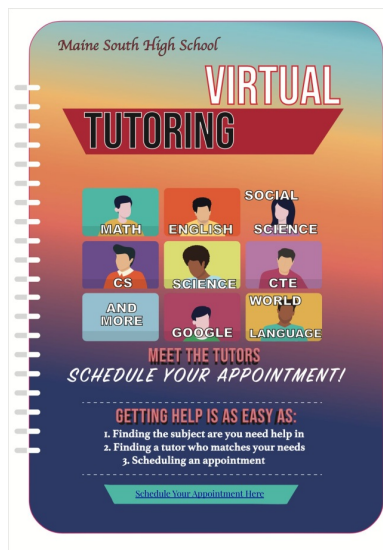
Pass/NG Procedures

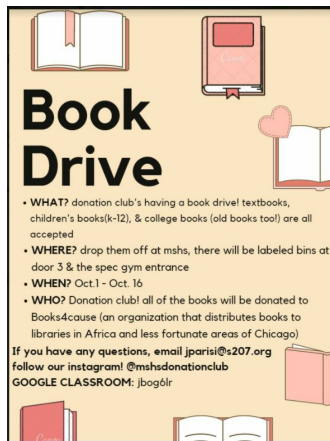

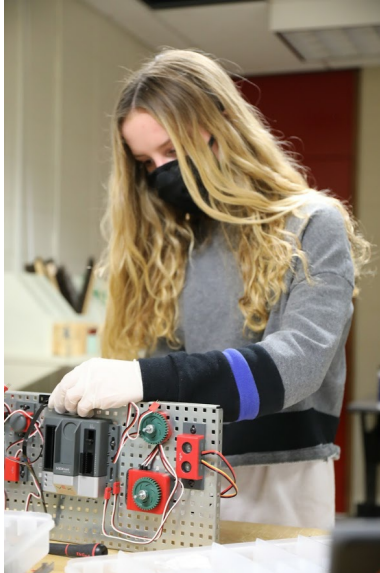
