Dear Maine South Senior Parents and Students (Class of 2021),

Students interested in applying for the parking lottery for the 2020-21 school year must meet the following criteria:

- Have not received any out of school or in school suspensions during their junior year.
- Have served all their assigned disciplinary consequences.
- Have not had any 24/7 violations.
- Have paid any outstanding school obligations (fees, fines, books due etc.).
- Completed [Cap & Gown Survey](#)
- Signed off on [Student Handbook](#)

Priorities for the lottery will be provided as follows:

1. Students enrolled in our Internship program whose placement requires a parking pass.
2. Senior students who can verify that they will be driving with at least one other senior classmate, and agree to follow safety protocols (*wearing a mask when in the car together and windows open when weather permits*). In this case, only **one** parking permit will be issued to these senior carpoolers. We are requiring guardian signatures for all senior students who will be driving to school in the same vehicle.
3. The remaining permits will be distributed to seniors who have met the above criteria.

* Please note: On-campus parking is a privilege, therefore, student behavior, attendance, and academic standing are factors administration will take into consideration when determining students' access to parking. The school reserves the right to revoke a student's parking permit without a refund.

The process for entering [senior parking permit sales](#) is as follows:

1. Beginning **Wednesday, October 21st, 2020, eligible Seniors**, including those enrolled in the Internship Program, must complete the following [google form](#) using their Maine South student email account by midnight Sunday, November 1, 2020.
2. Dates to remember:
 - November 1st: Senior Parking Lottery Form submission will close at midnight. Late applications will not be accepted.
 - November 6th: An email will be sent to those Seniors who have been selected to purchase a parking permit. At that time, students will complete the Parking Application Form.

Until parking permits have been issued, all seniors will be able to park on-campus on a "first-come, first-serve" basis. Student parking is permitted in the following lots: A-wing lot and Northeast lot (behind the fieldhouse.) Enforcement of permitted parking will begin on November 30.

Parking Permit costs are currently being finalized, but will be offered at a reduced rate this year.
