3. We will also be giving away exclusive Red Cross T-Shirts at the Blood Drive.

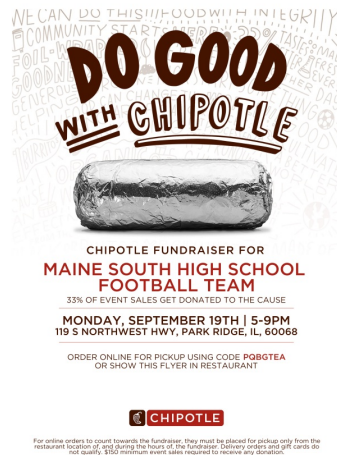
How to donate food for the Maine Township Food Pantry:
