Pass/NG Procedures

The purpose of the pass/NG option is to provide students opportunities for learning which minimize the pressure of grades and impact on a student's overall Grade Point Average (G.P.A.). The pass/NG option is an option for elective courses, but is not eligible for courses that are accelerated/AP, dual credit or required for graduation.

When choosing an eligible course for the Pass/No Grade Option, the following will appear on the transcript:

- A passing grade (D or above) will be reflected in your transcript as a "P" for Pass, will receive credit and will not count towards your GPA.
- A failing grade will be reflected as an "NG" for No Grade and will not receive credit and not count towards your GPA.

If you submit this form for a year-long class during the first semester you <u>do not</u> need to resubmit the form again for the 2nd semester. It will automatically apply to both semesters unless you notify your counselor.

Students may take "Pass/NG" according to the following guidelines:

- Students may petition to take courses 'Pass/NG' only if they are registered for more than four full credit courses. If a student who is taking a fifth course 'Pass/NG' decides to drop a course that is being taken for a letter grade, the pass/NG course must be taken for a letter grade.
- Students must meet all prerequisites for admission to any class they wish to take Pass/NG. Accelerated, AP and Dual Credit courses can not be taken 'Pass/NG'.
- Courses required for graduation are not eligible for 'Pass/NG' except for courses taken to complete the two-year graduation requirement in applied arts and technology, fine arts, or foreign language.
