GREAT AMERICA GRAD NIGHT – Saturday May 9th – Sunday, May 10th, 2026

- Ticketed students need to arrive between 7:30 - 8:00 pm to get checked in. Buses load at 8:30 p.m. in the jock lot (Saturday, May 10th). Buses return at 3:45 a.m. in the north lot (Sunday, May 11th).
- Tickets are **\$90** each (includes transportation to the park, entrance ticket, and food).
- Only 375 student tickets will be available and tickets will be sold at the bookstore. In order to purchase a ticket you must have been selected from the ticket lottery. Tickets will be on sale in the bookstore from Monday, March 30th until Wednesday, April 8th.
- **NO** tickets will be sold without the emergency form and your student ID/Infinite Campus page. **You are only allowed to purchase a ticket for yourself. NO** refunds can be granted. **NO** swaps will be accepted. If you purchase a ticket you are the only person who can attend.

SENIOR BREAKFAST – Saturday, May 2nd, 2026 (9:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m.)

- Seniors are invited to celebrate the end of four years of high school at the Senior Breakfast on Saturday, May 2nd, at Manzo's Banquets located at 1572 S Elmhurst Rd in Des Plaines from 9:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m. Doors open at 9:00 a.m., all you can eat breakfast buffet begins at 9:30 a.m. No admittance after 9:30 a.m. Business casual attire is expected, as well as a 5 star ticket and Maine South ID. Tickets will be on sale for the Senior Breakfast on the [5 Star store site](#) from April 9th to April 17th. No tickets will be sold after April 17th and no tickets will be sold at the door. No refunds. Cost is \$35 per student.
- Come and celebrate the end of your four years at Maine South with fellow seniors. There will be a short program including the awarding of Senior Superlatives, announcing the Prom Court, and a senior slideshow.

SENIOR PROM: The Roaring Twenties – Friday, May 15th, 2025 (6:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.)

- Prom will be held at The Westin, 400 Park Blvd, Itasca, IL 60143 on Friday, May 15th. The doors will open at 6:00 p.m. with a reception from 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. (**no admittance after 7:00 p.m.**). A sit-down, formal dinner will be served from 7:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. with dancing to follow.
- Tickets will be sold on the 5 Star store from April 20th to May 1st. The ticket price is \$85 per person. No tickets will be sold after May 1st and no tickets will be sold at the door. No Refunds. - Maine South ID (photo ID for guests) is required. Guests must be under 21 years of age to attend. Bags will be checked upon entry to the venue.
- If you or your guest require a vegan, vegetarian or special diet meal, you will be able to indicate this in a survey prior to the event.

Commencement Speaker
